



### **Docteure Nancy Vasil**

Docteure Nancy Vasil is a psychiatrist since 1998 (graduated from Sherbrooke University, Québec). She underwent a clinical research fellowship in 2000 at Centre Hospitalier Régional Universitaire of Montpellier, France and INSERM *Institut National de la Santé et de la Recherche Médicale*, concerning links between cardiac, neurovascular and psychiatric disorders in geriatric population.

She is a certified CRMCC geriatric psychiatrist (2013) and an assistant professor at Montreal University Psychiatry Department. She practices in consultation-liaison (geriatrics, neurology, cardiology, internal medicine, intensive care, long term care, evaluation of donor in kidney transplant program), at geriatric psychiatry outclinic and as a geriatric psychiatric consultant at the memory clinic of Maisonneuve-Rosemont Hospital in Montreal (HMR), an affiliated Montreal University center. She is currently head of Geriatric Psychiatry Service at HMR. She teaches residents in psychiatry and residents in subspecialty in geriatric psychiatry.

She is a member of the Geriatric Psychiatry Subspecialty Committee of Montréal University, the first subspecialty program accredited by RCPSC in Quebec in 2014. She has been part of CAGP Board of Directors since 2013 and is currently Chair of Communication Committee since 2014 and an active member of Membership Committee and ASM Committee. She is member of RCPSC Examination Committee for subspecialty in Geriatric Psychiatry.

She will also act as a medical expert in geriatric psychiatry for professional inspection visit for le Collège des Médecins du Québec.

Docteure Vasil is dedicated to clinical care of geriatric psychiatry, consultation-liaison and psychiatric patients, and, besides her current commitments, to teaching (past coordinator for medical externs and residents), to administrative work (past head of Consultation-Liaison Service of HMR 2004-2008), professional work ( past member of

Executive Committee of SQCM: *Société Québécoise de Consultation-Liaison et de Médecine Psychosomatique* and secretary of this organization from 2006-2009), to living condition of seniors in long-term care centers in Quebec, to quality of medical practice and to academic work (main author of chapter 27 *Troubles neurocognitifs*, in *Psychiatrie Clinique, Lalonde et Pinard* to be publish in 2016, co-author of an article about delirium in *Médecin du Québec* (2012), one of the authors of 2014 *Delirium diagnosis and treatment algorithm for HMR*).
