

Dr Joel Sadavoy

Professor of Psychiatry, University of Toronto, Inaugural CAGP President

Dr. Joel Sadavoy, is professor of psychiatry, and member of the Institute of Medical Sciences and Neurosciences program, at the University of Toronto. He is head of Geriatric and Ethno cultural Community Psychiatry, and founder and Director of the Reitman Centre for Alzheimer's Support and Training at Mount Sinai Hospital where he is the inaugural holder of the Pencer Family Chair in Applied General Psychiatry and the immediate past Psychiatrist in Chief. His key academic interests have been in service development research and implementation, most recently in the area of family caregivers of persons with dementia, ethno cultural psychiatry, and psychotherapy of the elderly. He is the founding past president of the Canadian Academy of Geriatric Psychiatry, and a Past president of the International Psychogeriatric association.
